

Make a bird feeder

You will need:

- String
- Lard
- Pine cone
- Birdseed
- Bowl
- Tablespoon



Instructions:

1. Leave pine cones to open in a dry place for a few weeks
2. Use the lard at room temperature so it will be soft. You will need a spoon full of lard for each cone
4. Put the lard into a bowl. Add birdseed and mix well with the spoon
5. Tie a string to the top of the pine cone
6. Use the spoon or your fingers to push the mixture between the blades of the cone until it is covered
8. Hang the feeder on a branch or somewhere that birds can easily find it. Top it up when all the seeds have gone
9. Enjoy watching the birds visiting your feeder
